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**Title of Session** Teaching Games for Understanding**Description** Workshop for Intermediate & Secondary Physical Education Teachers – Catholic Schools

This full day interactive workshop is designed for teachers who are discovering Teaching Games for Understanding (TGfU) for the first time or with very little experience. This session will give an overview of where the approach originates, why it works, and what it does. The presentation works with the ideas from Assessment for learning to pull out the fundamental structures of TGfU classifications and notions of appropriate student learning chunking of knowledge and how assessment for learning is integrated in TGFU.

Attending teachers will participate in TGfU games including:

- a) Invasion Games; for example, soccer. The session will include some of the basics of the TGfU model steps and the Games Performance Assessment Instrument, which falls into the philosophy of the Assessment for learning approach.
- b) Net games to review the pedagogical principles of exaggeration-modification and the concepts of spatial awareness, width, depth.
- c) Striking Games; for example, Danish Long ball.
