**Title of Session** **EARLY INTERVENTION:  
DATA ANALYSIS AND PLANNING**

**Description** In response to feedback from schools over the past few years, an Early Intervention Data Analysis & Planning Day has been organized to assist schools analyze and interpret their data. Teachers will have an opportunity to discuss educational planning issues and determine when additional assessments and/or further investigation should be suggested to parents.

Based on the data analysis, school teams will also be assembling an Early Intervention Summer Package suitable for each student. The activities are meant for students to practice early literacy and numeracy skills over the summer.
